His father died soon after his birth and the family moved to County Antrim where his education was paid for by a benevolent farmer, which allowed him to study English at Belfast. He married Jane Boyd and they emigrated to Pennsylvania in 1784 where they lived until 1792. During that time he taught at Pennsylvania College and having discovered a Hebrew Bible by chance became interested in and studied Hebrew. They then moved again for James to read Chemistry, Anatomy and Theology at Edinburgh University. He taught Hebrew (known as 'Oriental' language at the time) at Edinburgh, progressing to Professor of Oriental Language at Marischal College, Aberdeen and eventually became a Preacher in 1796. He was known as a popular but sometimes controversial figure. After five years, he left the college to become a Minister at the Gilcomston Chapel of Ease; he died in 1834.
